SPECIAL MEETING

May 23, 2017

The Cameron Parish Police Jury met in special session on Tuesday, May 23, 2017, in the Grand Lake Conference Center in the Village of Grand Lake, Louisiana at 6:00 P.M. The following members were present: Mr. Kirk Quinn, Mr. Curtis Fountain, Mr. Terry Beard, Mr. Davey Doxey, Mr. Anthony Hicks, Mr. Joe Dupont and Mr. Darryl Farque. Mr. Lawrence Faulk was absent.

It was moved by Mr. Beard, seconded by Mr. Dupont and carried, that the board hereby adopts Ad Valorem Millage Rates for 2017.
