SPECIAL SESSION

SEPTEMBER 24, 2018

The Cameron Parish Police Jury met in special session on Monday, September 24, 2018, in the Cameron Parish West Annex Board Room in the Village of Cameron, Louisiana at 4:30 o'clock P.M. The following members were present: Mr. Joe Dupont, Mr. Davy Doxey, Mr. Darryl Farque, Mr. Anthony Hicks, Mr. Terry Beard, Mr. Kirk Quinn and Mr. Lawrence Faulk. The following member was absent: Mr. Magnus McGee.

It was moved by Mr. Quinn, seconded by Mr. Farque and carried, the following resolution was duly adopted.

**RESOLUTION**

**STATE OF LOUISIANA  
PARISH OF CAMERON**

**WHEREAS**, at the regular session of the Cameron Parish Police Jury held on May 4, 2018, the Board resolved to levy a millage of 2.50 mills for the Fire Protection District No. 7 Sinking.

**WHEREAS**, the Cameron Parish Assessor's Office has submitted the 2018 Tax Roll for Cameron Parish that reflects a fifty-four percent (54%) reduction in taxable value in the Fire Protection District No. 7 taxing district from 2017,

**WHEREAS**, the law provides that the millage rate for payment of general obligation bonds must generate revenue sufficient to meet the annual debt service payments due in that year and the projected revenue from the 2018 Tax Roll for Fire Protection District No. 7 Sinking are not sufficient based on the 2.50 millage rate levied,

**THEREFORE**, the Cameron Parish Police Jury hereby rescinds the certain portion of the resolution adopted on May 4, 2018, that levied a millage of 2.50 mills for the Fire Protection District No. 7 Sinking.

**RESOLUTION**

**STATE OF LOUISIANA  
PARISH OF CAMERON**

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the following millage is hereby levied on the 2018 tax roll on all property subject to taxation by Cameron Parish Police Jury:

<u>DISTRICT</u>	<u>MILLAGE</u>
Fire Protection District No. 7 Sinking	6.00 MILLS

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proper administrative officials of the Parish of Cameron, State of Louisiana, be and they are hereby empowered, authorized, and directed to spread said taxes, as hereinabove set forth, upon the assessment roll of said Parish for the year 2018, and to make the collection of the taxes imposed for and on behalf of the taxing authority, according to law, and that the taxes herein levied shall become a permanent lien and privilege on all property subject to taxation as herein set forth, and collection thereof shall be enforceable in the manner provided by law.

The foregoing resolution was read in full, the roll was called on the adoption thereof, and the resolution was adopted by the following votes:
