 - a. Shelf Energy LLC – Hackberry, Section 20 & 28, T12S, R12W, (proposed Brown Odom-Pintail Alley Facility, installation of (2) 6-inch connector flowlines at existing facility to adjacent buried pipelines, (1) 6-inch connector pipeline, and SWD Well), Cameron Parish, LA. (181201)

 - a. CAJJ, LLC – Creole, Trosclair Rd. Section 31, T14S, R7W, (proposed development of RV Park, office, and laundromat providing approximately 105 RV Spaces, to support temporary housing for construction workers and recreational camp sites), Cameron Parish, LA. (181202)
 - b. Jordan Lands, LLC – Sweetlake, Off LA Hwy. 384, Section 17, T12S, R7W, (proposed excavation of borrow/pit, approximately 142 acres, to provide fill material for local industry and infrastructure), Cameron Parish, LA. (181203)
