The Cameron Parish Police Jury met in special session on Thursday, October 29, 2020 in the Grand Lake Conference Center in the Village of Grand Lake, Louisiana at 5:00 P.M. A RESOLUTION TO CALL A SPECIAL ELECTION TO FILL THE ANTICIPATED VACANCY FULL TERM FOR CAMERON PARISH TAX ASSESSOR

WHEREAS, Mr. Darrell Williams, passed away on October 19, 2020, and although he had not yet been sworn in, he was elected the Cameron Parish Tax Assessor on October 12, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to R.S. 18:602, the Cameron Parish Police Jury, the governing authority of Cameron Parish, shall call a special election to fill the full term of the Cameron Parish Tax Assessor; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ROSOLVED, that the Cameron Police Jury does hereby call a special election for Cameron Parish Tax Assessor to fill the full term, with the election to be held on March 20, 2021, primary and April 24, 2020 general with qualifying dates January 20, 21 and 22, 2021 and furthermore copies of this resolution shall be sent to by certified or registered mail to the Cameron Parish Clerk of Court and to the Secretary of State of the State of Louisiana.
