CAMERON PARISH POLICE JURY  
BUDGET MEETING

NOVEMBER 13, 2020

The Cameron Parish Police Jury met in regular session on Friday November 13, 2020, in the Cameron Parish West Annex Board Room in the Village of Cameron, Louisiana at 1:00 o'clock P.M. for review of the 2021 budget.
