

SWCLA PROJECT- HOME ELEVATIONS

What is this?

The US Army Corps of Engineers and Louisiana Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority (CPRA) are elevating homes in the region to manage risks from hurricanes and storms.

What's covered?

- ✓ Raising your home 3-13 feet
- ✓ Utility and structural adjustments

What's not covered?

- ✗ Temporary relocations for homeowners
- ✗ Add-ons or upgrades
- ✗ Hazardous material remediation (mold, asbestos, lead, etc.)

Is your home eligible?

Around 3,900 properties are eligible in Cameron, Calcasieu and Vermilion Parishes. You may be one of them!

Scan this QR code to find out if you are eligible and apply.



What is required?

- Home is in the lowest floodplain in Cameron, Calcasieu or Vermilion Parishes
- Home is structurally sound
- Applicant possesses a clear title and owns the home
- No unresolved estate issues or liens on the home
- Have not received previous federal funding for elevation
- Properties must be free of hazardous materials or contamination (mold, asbestos, lead, etc.)
- Homeowner agrees the area below the elevated floor remains non-habitable (can be used for parking, storage, access, etc.)

What else?

This is 100% voluntary and there is *no cost-share!*

Buyouts and acquisitions are not allowed. Flood insurance is not required for participation.
