## WHAT ELSE YOU NEED TO KNOW

- This is 100% voluntary and there is **no cost-share!**
- Flood insurance is not required for participation.
- Buyouts and acquisitions are not allowed.

## IS YOUR HOME ELIGIBLE?

Around 3,900 properties are eligible in Cameron, Calcasieu, and Vermilion Parishes – you may be one of them!

## WHAT'S COVERED IN A HOME ELEVATION?

- Covered costs:
  - Raising your home 3-13 feet
  - Utility and structural adjustments
- NOT covered:
  - Temporary relocation for homeowners
  - Add-ons or upgrades
  - Hazardous material remediation (mold/asbestos, lead, etc.)

## WHAT IS REQUIRED?

- Home must be in the lowest floodplain in Cameron, Calcasieu or Vermilion Parishes
- Home must be structurally sound
- Applicant possesses a clear title and owns the home
- No unresolved estate issues or liens on the home
- Have not received previous federal funding for elevation
- Properties must be free from hazardous materials or contamination (mold, asbestos, lead, etc.)
- Homeowner agrees to keep the area below elevated floor non-habitable (can be used for parking, access, storage, etc.)
