  - a. Hilcorp Energy Company – Sweetlake, Chalkey Field, (proposes to install (1) 4-inch flowline to serve the Sweet Lake L&O No. 001 Well), Cameron Parish, LA. (250703)
  - b. Key Operating Co. - Oak Grove, Section 9, T14S, R7W, (proposes well site for the S.L. 22210 No. 4 for the exploration of Oil and Gas.), Cameron Parish, LA. (250715)
7. Motion to Approve Other Permits:
  - a. Entergy Louisiana, LLC - Hackberry, Gum Cove Road and LA 27 West, (proposes replacement of 80 wooden poles to improve resiliency of the distribution grid during hurricanes or other severe weather events), Cameron Parish, LA. (250701)
  - b. Volkert, Inc. – Johnson Bayou, 5022 Gulf Beach, (proposes 12 acre property to be utilized for parking/staging of vehicles and equipment overnight for work on power lines for Jeff Davis Electric Co-Op, Inc. No improvements such as fill is being added to site), Cameron Parish, LA. (250702)
  - c. Sulphur River Exploration, Inc. – Grand Chenier, Collicon Lake, (proposes placement of produced water storage barge on location at the Miami Alternatives No. 1 well/production site), Cameron Parish, LA. (250704)

- d. Cameron Lane Venture, LLC – Cameron, 301 Wakefield Road, (proposes to place approximately 4,249 cubic yards of gravel fill in a developed upland commercial site on the east bank of Calcasieu Ship Channel. The site was previously developed as a commercial drilling mud plant and mooring facility under P20041751. Gravel will be hauled in and placed on site, graded, and compacted to a height of 4 inches for equipment and material storage to support construction of the CP2 LNG Terminal), Cameron Parish, LA. (250705)
- e. Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company, LLC - Off Mermentau River Road, (proposes anomaly dig site along TGP 26” 507F-100 Pipeline to assess pipeline conditions and identify any deficiencies that may require repair or replacement), Cameron Parish, LA. (250706)
- f. Sabine Pass Liquefaction, LLC; Sabine Pass Liquefaction Stage V, LLC; Sabine Crossing, LLC - Cameron, Off Davis Road, (proposes expansion of the existing Sabine Pass Liquefied Natural Gas Facility and construction of a new 48-inch diameter natural gas pipeline. Project includes addition of three (3) natural gas liquefaction trains, one (1) Boil off gas (BOG) re-liquefaction unit, and supporting infrastructure including a permanent laydown yard in Lake Charles), Cameron Parish, LA. (250707)
- g. LA Bay CamOps, LLC - Cameron, 183 Bobbies Lane, (proposes construction of gravel pad for vehicles, equipment parking, and temporary staging of construction material. This will result in 7000 cubic yards of fill material within 7 acres), Cameron Parish, LA. (250708)
- h. Cameron Parish Gravity Drainage District No. 4 - Creole, Off Little Chenier Road, (Maintenance of Lateral “K”; proposes an extension to perform maintenance dredging along 4,157 linear feet of drainage lateral to provide adequate drainage), Cameron Parish, LA. (250709)
- i. William and Laura Taylor - Grand Lake, 1344 Highway 384, (proposes excavation of 3,704 cubic yards for pond to construct residential pad and shop. All material to remain on site), Cameron Parish, LA. (250710)
- j. Cameron Parish Gravity Drainage District No. 4 – Creole, Off Highway 27/82, (Maintenance of Lateral “B”; proposes an extension to perform maintenance dredging along 7,313 linear feet of drainage lateral to provide adequate drainage), Cameron Parish, LA. (250711)
- k. Cameron Parish Gravity Drainage District No. 4 – Creole, Off Highway 27/82, (Maintenance of Lateral “Q”; proposes an extension to perform maintenance dredging along 1,229 linear feet of drainage lateral to provide adequate drainage), Cameron Parish, LA. (250712)
- l. Cameron Parish Gravity Drainage District No. - Creole, Off Highway 27/82, (Maintenance of Lateral “G”; proposes an extension to perform maintenance dredging along 6,642 linear feet of drainage lateral to provide adequate drainage), Cameron Parish, LA. (250713)

This will result in 4,155.50 cubic yards of excavations and 24,243.90 cubic yards of fill area which includes crushed stone or gravel and sand. Security fencing will be installed to control ingress and egress.), Cameron Parish, LA. (250715)
