CAMERON PARISH POLICE JURY

APRIL 13, 2026

The Cameron Parish Police Jury met in regular session on Monday, April 13, 2026, in the Cameron Parish West Annex Board Room in the Village of Cameron, Louisiana, at 12:37 P.M.

The following members were present: Mr. Michael Fewell, Mr. Magnus McGee, Mr. Ronald Nunez, Jr., Mr. Mark Daigle, Mr. Sam Bordelon, and Mr. Johnny Watson. Mr. Wendell Wilkerson was absent.

The following public comments on the agenda items were presented:

Item 27 - Mark Daigle, I would like to make things easier for jurors and the public to get on the agenda.

Item 28 - Mark Daigle, if it affects property or livelihood, it needs to be done.

Item 17 - Adley Dyson, I think this is a good idea and enforcement needs to be done correctly.

Item 24 & 25 - Ryan Jordan, All RV parks should be considered for fencing not just those with 25 or more spots.

It was moved by Mr. Nunez, seconded by Mr. Bordelon, and carried that the reading of the minutes shall be dispensed with and approved.

It was moved by Mr. Daigle, seconded by Mr. McGee, and carried, the board hereby removes item 7b from the agenda. Recreation District No. 9 appointment for Susie Fawvor whose term expired, per Recreation Board request, remove this seat to comply with Revised Statue.

It was moved by Mr. McGee, seconded by Mr. Watson, the board hereby removed item 8, amendment to food truck ordinance from the agenda.

It was moved by Mr. McGee, seconded by Mr. Daigle, and carried unanimously. Appointment Item 7c - Cameron Parish Port Harbor & Terminal - Alfred Devall resigned, appoint Kirk Sanner for remainder of the term is hereby added to the agenda.

It was moved by Mr. Bordelon, seconded by Mr. Nunez, and carried unanimously. Item 24 - Consideration of permit for Verret RV Park, LLC (170 spot), with stipulation that the owner provides fencing and complies with ordinances and state laws (will receive requirements from the permit department per jury direction) be added to the agenda.

It was moved by Mr. Nunez, seconded by Mr. Watson, and carried unanimously. Item 25 - Consideration of permit for Hackberry RV Park (64 spot), with stipulation that the owner provides fencing and complies with ordinances and state laws (will receive requirements from the permit department per jury direction) be added to the agenda.

It was moved by Mr. Daigle, seconded by Mr. Bordelon, and carried unanimously. Item 26 - Consideration of revising the Public Records Request Policy be added to the agenda.

It was moved by Mr. Daigle, seconded by Mr. Bordelon, and carried unanimously. Item 27 - Consideration of revising the Meeting Policy be added to the agenda.

It was moved by Mr. Daigle, seconded by Mr. Bordelon, and carried unanimously. Item 28 - Consideration of declaring a State of Emergency on drainage and the VG spill be added to the agenda.

It was moved by Mr. Nunez, seconded by Mr. Daigle, and carried, that the application for the following permits be and the same is hereby approved with the stipulations set forth by the respective Gravity Drainage Districts:

It was moved by Mr. McGee, seconded by Mr. Nunez, and carried, the board hereby accepts the resignation of Alfred Devall from the Cameron Port Harbor & Terminal District. Appoints Kirk Sanner to the Ward 6 seat for the remainder of the term and directs the secretary to send a letter of appreciation to Mr. Devall for his service to the board.

It was moved by Mr. McGee, seconded by Mr. Bordelon, and carried, the board hereby authorizes, empowers, and directs the president to sign the Multi-Jurisdictional Agreement between Cameron, Calcasieu, Allen, Beauregard, Jeff Davis, and Vernon Parish Police Jury for Workforce Development.

It was moved by Mr. Nunez, seconded by Mr. Watson, and carried, the board hereby approves the appropriation in the amount of \$12,000.00 for the Council on Aging Meal Program.

It was moved by Mr. Nunez, seconded by Mr. Waston, and carried, the board hereby grants authority to advertise sealed bids for the Official Journal.

It was moved by Mr. Daigle, seconded by Mr. Nunez, and carried, the board hereby appoints the Parish Secretary, Mary Carroll, as Custodian of Records.

It was moved by Mr. McGee, seconded by Mr. Daigle, and carried, the board hereby grants authority to advertise the No Wake Zone Ordinance.

It was moved by Mr. Nunez, seconded by Mr. Watson, and carried, the board hereby grants authority to increase the contract for Porche/May Architects+Domain Architecture in the amount of \$2,204.00 for design services fees due to additional work requested by owner.

In response to the Request for Qualifications for the Cameron Sewer Lift Station Upgrades, the following proposals were submitted; Fairway Consulting & Engineering, Fenstermaker, K&M Project Services, Meyer & Associates, and Neel-Schaffer. Considering Meyer & Associates received the highest overall score, it was moved by Mr. McGee, seconded by Mr. Nunez, and carried, the board hereby approves Meyer & Associates for the Cameron Sewer Lift Station Upgrades, and grants the president authority to sign all required documents for said RFQ.

In response to the Request for Qualifications for the Cameron Pump Station Reconstruction and Elevation Project, the following proposals were submitted; Fairway Consulting & Engineering, GIS Engineering, K&M Project Services, and Waggoner Engineering. Considering Waggoner Engineering received the highest overall score, it was moved by Mr. McGee, seconded by Mr. Nunez, and carried, the board hereby approves Waggoner Engineering for the Cameron Pump Station Reconstruction & Elevation Project, and grants the president authority to sign all required documents for said RFQ.

It was moved by Mr. Bordelon, seconded by Mr. Nunez, and carried, the board hereby approves the permit for Verret Park, LLC, (170 spots) with the stipulation the park complies with ordinances and state laws and provides fencing with a height required by adjacent land owner, or receives a letter of no objection from the adjacent land owner concerning the installation of fencing. Mr. Verret has agreed to the stipulations.

It was moved by Mr. McGee, seconded by Mr. Watson, and carried, the board hereby approves the permit for Hackberry RV Park, (64 spots) with the stipulation the park complies with ordinances and state laws and provides fencing with a height required by adjacent land owner, or receives a letter of no objection from the adjacent land owner concerning the installation of fencing. Mr. Boudreaux has agreed to the stipulations.

It was moved by Mr. Daigle, seconded by Mr. Bordelon, and carried, the board hereby agrees to review a draft revising the Public Records Request Policy pertaining to who receives the requests.

It was moved by Mr. Daigle, seconded by Mr. Watson, and carried, the board hereby agrees to review a draft revising the Meeting Policy.

It was moved by Mr. Daigle, seconded by Mr. McGee, and carried, the board hereby agrees to review a draft declaring a local State of Emergency on drainage and the VG spill.

It was moved by Mr. Daigle, seconded by Mr. Watson, and carried, the board hereby tables Executive Session to next month.

It was moved by Mr. Daigle, seconded by Mr. Watson, and carried, the motion to table Executive Session to next month is rescinded.

It was moved by Mr. Daigle, seconded by Mr. Watson, and carried, the board will go into executive session for:

- b. Katie Armentor - Performance Evaluation Discussion
