WATER DISCHARGE PERMIT AND
THE ASSOCIATED ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT STATEMENT (EAS)

EXTENSION OF COMMENT PERIOD

The comment period is being extended from Thursday, May 28, 2026, to Monday, June 1, 2026.

The LDEQ, Office of Environmental Services, will conduct a public hearing to receive comments on a draft Louisiana Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (LPDES) permit and the Associated Environmental Assessment Statement (EAS) prepared for Venture Global CP2 LNG, LLC, 1401 McKinney Street, Suite 2600, Houston, TX 77010 for the CP2 LNG Terminal. **The facility is located at 235 Davis Road in Cameron, Cameron Parish.**

The public hearing will now be held on **Thursday, May 28, 2026, beginning at 6:00 p.m., at the Cameron Parish Multi-Purpose Building located at 122 Recreation Center Lane, Cameron, Louisiana 70631.** During the hearing, all interested persons will have an opportunity to present oral statements, views, recommendations, opinions and information on the proposed permit. Additionally, written statements and other documents such as charts, data, and tabulations may be filed with the hearing officer at the hearing.

The principal discharge from this proposed source is made into Calcasieu Pass via pipes and Calcasieu Ship Channel via pipes and local drainage, waters of the state classified for primary contact recreation, secondary contact recreation, propagation of fish and wildlife, and oyster propagation. Under the SIC Code 4925, the applicant proposes to discharge first flush and post first flush process area stormwater, non-process area stormwater, miscellaneous non-process wastewaters, commissioning waters, utility waters, backwashes, condensates, building washdown, and equipment washwater from a proposed liquefied natural gas production, storage and export terminal.

During the preparation of this permit, it has been determined that this discharge will have no adverse impact on the existing uses of the receiving waterbody. As with any discharge, however, some change in existing water quality may occur.

The EAS submitted by the applicant addresses avoidance of potential and real environmental effects, balancing of social and economic benefits against environmental impact costs, and alternative sites, projects, and mitigative measures.

This permit was processed as an expedited permit in accordance with LAC 33:I.Chapter 18.

The public hearing will be conducted in accordance with La. R.S. 30:2017, which addresses the authority of the hearing officer, provides for the order in which speakers will be allowed to speak. A hearing officer will preside over the public hearing. This will be a formal hearing for the purpose of gathering facts and information. It will not include a “question and answer” component. In accordance with La. R.S. 30:2016, the hearing will be transcribed and become a part of the official public record.

Comments or requests for notification of the final decision can be submitted via personal delivery, U.S. mail, or email. **Comments must be received by 4:30 pm CDT, Monday, June 1, 2026.** Delivery may be made to the drop-box at 602 N. 5th St., Baton Rouge, LA 70802. U.S. Mail may be sent to LDEQ, Public Participation Group,

P.O. Box 4313, Baton Rouge, LA 70821-4313. Emails may be submitted to DEQ.PUBLICNOTICES@LA.GOV. Persons wishing to receive notice of the final permit action must include a complete mailing address when submitting comments.

A written response to all public comments will be prepared at the time of the final permit decision. LDEQ will send notification of the final permit decision to the applicant and to each person who has submitted written comments or a written request for notification of the final decision.

The application, additional information, draft permit and Statement of Basis are available for review at the LDEQ, Public Records Center, 602 North 5th Street, Baton Rouge, LA. Viewing hours are from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday (except holidays). **The available information can also be accessed electronically on the Electronic Document Management System (EDMS) on the DEQ public website at www.deq.louisiana.gov.**
